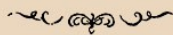
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MATERIALS

1 Ozark Mane
1 skein Ozark Handspun yarn

DIRECTIONS

Using a P crochet hook, chain stitch varying lengths from 3" to 6" and attach them to the pelt around the outer edge of the pelt as well as some places in the pelt. It is easy to do this by putting the end of the yarn through the pelt with a slip stitch. This is also a good way to correct the areas where the pelt may be a little thin. You may also leave a tail of several inches since the yarn has so much texture.

This is such an easy piece to do for such a big payoff in style! Wear and start counting the compliments.
