

Ozark Handspun and Dune Scarf

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MATERIALS

2 Ozark Handspun Yarn
1 Louet Kidlin Worsted Weight
1 Dune By Trendsetter
#17 And #35 Needles

MEASUREMENTS

10" X 72"

INSTRUCTIONS

With a #17 needle, cast on 20 stitches in Dune and knit 4 rows.

Cut and tie on Kidlin and knit 6 rows.

Cut and tie on Ozark. Switching to #35 needles, knit 2 together across row (10 sts).

Knit 3 more rows.

Cut Ozark and tie on Kidlin. Switch to #17 needles and increase 1 st in each st across the row (20 sts.)

Knit 4 rows.

Cut and tie on Dune and knit 6 rows.

In other words:

Dune, 4 rows, #17, 20 sts

Kidlin, 6 rows #17, 20 sts

Ozark, 4 rows, #35, 10 ssts

Kidlin, 4 rows, #17, 20 sts

Dune, 6 rows, #17, 20 sts

Ozark, 4 rows, #35, 10 sts

Continue in pattern for 72". This is one suggestion for striping, but feel free to vary it as you wish. The completed scarf had 40 rows of Ozark, 60 rows of Kidlin and 54 rows of Dune with leftovers of Dune and Kidlin for additional rows. If you want to add more rows of Ozark you will need another skein.

Finishing

Using the second ball of Ozark and a size P crochet hook, single crochet loosely around the entire edge of the piece.

Wrap Option

If you would rather make a wrap than a shawl, simply double the number of sts and buy one more skein of Ozark and 1 more skein of Dune.
