Ozark Leafy Scarf

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MATERIALS:

2 Ozark Handspun Yarn in Retro

1 Cashmere in Granny Smith

1 US Size 35 needles

Optional: Wonder Knitter by clover for I-cord

INSTRUCTIONS:

Cast on 8 sts in Ozark with a #35 needle. Knit until you have completely used up the 2 skeins.

Following directions that come with the Wonder Knitter (or knit an i-cord traditionally using double pointed needles) make a cord 2 ¾ yds long. Use the remaining cashmere to make the leaves. I made 3 large, 10 medium and 8 small.

LARGE LEAF: cast on 5 sts.

 Row 1: RS, K2, yo, k1, yo, k2 (7sts.))
 Row 11: Ssk, k7, k2tog (9sts)

 Row 2 and all WS rows: Purl)
 Row 13: Ssk, k5, k2tog (7 sts)

 Row3: K3, yo, k1,yo, k3 (9 sts)
 Row 15: Ssd, k3, k2tog (5 sts.)

 Row 5: K4,yo,k1,yo, k4 (11 sts.)
 Row 17: Ssk, k1, k2tog (3 sts)

 Row 7: K5, yo, k1, yo, k5 (13 sts.)
 Row 19: Sl 1, k2tog, psso (1 st) BO.

Row 9: Ssk, k9, k2tog . (11 sts)

MEDIUM LEAF: cast on 5 sts.

Follow directions for large leaf through row 6 only (11 sts). Then begin rows 11 through 19.

SMALL LEAF: cast on 5 sts.

Follow directions for large leaf through row 2. Then skip to row 15 through row19.

FINISHING:

Place i-cord on scarf as though it were a vine. Pin in place and sew with thread. Place leaves next to cord and sew in place. Vary the sizes and number of leaves. See photo.
